Dear mother + Dad,

We had a fine time with Mr. McWorkman when he was here. I am glad he got to come and I know he had a sweet time. He has probably told you all about it by now.

Mrs. McWorkman is starting home Sunday early. I am going to send some things home with her. I am going to send some little trees and some cactus if she will bring them. Plant the trees as soon as you can. We found some Red Cedar logs around camp and the past few days every one has been making things out of cedar.

I bought 2 new tubes from Sears Roebuck and shouldn't have any more tire trouble.

The weather has been fine cool at night and warm in the day. I have been going around with only shoes and pants on and I am getting a good coat of tan all over. I made corn bread yesterday and it sure was good. Our menu for yesterday dinner was,
