I expected a letter from you yesterday but I guess it will come tomorrow. Mail only comes Mon, Wed, and Sat and when we are up at camp we only get it when we come down Sun. We had another swell chicken dinner today with lemon ice to top it off.

Sordy and I were taking a bath at the spring the other day and the water was sure cold and the air was colder. We got the idea to have a little hot water so we built a fire under the pipe the water comes out and have running hot water now. It gets pretty hot and makes bathing pretty nice now.

The days are getting quite a bit colder and the other morning it was 38°. We sleep fine usually 12 hours every night. We get the newspapers dad sent and enjoyed them very much.

Don't send any more magazines or papers because we will be leaving soon.

We will only have one week and a few days at camp. We are going to break camp Aug 28, move down to the ranch, pack up Aug 29 and leave early Friday Aug 30. You can see on the map I marked the route we will take home.

We took a fine horseback trip to Daisy Canyon last Wednesday. We rode about 20 miles through mountains and cañons.

I am staying down to the ranch tonight and help with the washing tomorrow then either walk or ride up to camp.

Paul got two grouse the other day and we had grouse, french fried potatoes, home baked beans, bread + butter and jello. I think that was the best meal we have had yet.

Lordy made two Pumpkin pies the other day and they turned out swell.

I got a letter from Tommy and another fellow at King's. Tommy had some colored fellow write for him and the letter was sure funny.

I am getting kind of anxious to see you and every one at home but I still hate to leave camp. It seems almost like home to me
